

Alternative Assignment Rubric

Remember, you can come up with many ways to demonstrate mastery of the objectives to raise your grade on a test if you got below a 90%. Some examples include (but are not limited to) models, posters, and pamphlets. The purpose is NOT to show that you can copy definitions, but that you understand the concepts and how the vocabulary terms describe the concepts. Notice that simply defining the terms will result in no change in your grade.

The alternative assignment is meant to show mastery of the content that was not demonstrated on the assessment and is to be done outside of class while keeping up with current class work. The potential final grade takes into account your original summative assessment grade.
